CIRCULAR

In continuation to the University Notifications regarding Phased-manner re-opening of the campus and the observation of more than 281 positive cases (at present 27 active cases, including 24 students) have already been reported from the campus. As of now, total five deaths (including staff, family member of staff and pensioner) have been recorded. In August 2020, some blocks were declared as containment zones.

In view of the rising cases of Covid-19, following decisions have been taken for all the stakeholders of the University.

1. The Provosts and Wardens of the hostels are required to be vigilant and take all necessary measures to enforce COVID-19 guidelines such as strict enforcement of wearing of face masks, hand hygiene and social distancing. The Dean of Students may frame ethical guidelines and form hostel-level student committee to sensitize hostel residents for the adherence of the guidelines.
2. The NSS and NCC students should volunteer to create social awareness in all the common areas/premises of the campus in this regard.
3. The Sanitation Department shall facilitate the sanitization of workplace, common facilities and all points which frequently come into human contact, e.g., door handles, etc. All the stakeholders are encouraged to carry their own hand sanitizer.
4. The Security Department shall implement COVID-19 protocols at the entrance of all buildings. Any violations must be reported to the relevant authority such as Registrar, Dean, Chairperson or Senior Warden, or as the case may be.
5. Wearing face mask is mandatory in public places, including street, health centre, school buildings, library, offices, markets, dhabas etc. in the campus. The Security personnel are authorized to take photographs, if anyone is not wearing the face mask. Appropriate disciplinary action including fine shall be imposed in this regard.
6. All stakeholders are strictly instructed to maintain social distancing norms in public places.

7. The campus situation will be reviewed from time to time, and if the COVID-19 cases rise exponentially or lead to the potential development of Red zone and Containment zone, further measures are required which may include restricting the movement or reducing the number of person in the given premises or vacating of the premises.
8. The shopkeepers, staff of the canteens and other establishments are instructed to strictly follow the instruction to wear the mask at all the times. The goods are sold to those who arrive with mask only. Any violation would attract closure of shops/canteens for 2 days initially, and further violation will be dealt strictly as per guidelines/norms of the Government of India/Delhi Government/ University notification, etc.
9. Security Department is instructed to make aware the campus community and visitors through posters/banners and public address system etc. to follow the COVID-19 preventive guidelines.
10. Now, visitors' entry shall be restricted to only through the North gate of the campus.
11. Campus residents with 45 years and above age group are encouraged for COVID-19 vaccination.

Anyone who violates the above directions and COVID-19 protocols, shall be liable for disciplinary action.
